

General Advice on Parking in the University

Parking spaces marked RESERVED FOR STAFF / STUDENTS applies from Monday to Friday only. Visitors can park in these spaces on Saturday and Sunday without fear of being clamped.

Pay and Display Parking only applies Monday to Friday. No need to display a paid parking ticket at the weekend.

Please use only spaces marked for parking and do not park on double yellow lines.

There will be parking assistants on the grounds of the University to help guide you to the available parking areas.

There is no single major parking area but there are spaces for up to 1000 cars around the campus.

Although most students are away for the summer, many staff work on campus at the weekend so available spaces are occupied early.

Parking inside front entrance near the Quadrangle.

There are approx. 200 spaces in the area inside the main entrance on University Road (near the Cathedral).

It is a 5 minute walk to the Fleadh Office and the competition venues from this area.

Parking inside the entrance at Distillery Road /KingFisher Sports Centre

There are approx. 300 spaces in the area inside the Distillery Road /Kingfisher Sports Centre Entrance on Newcastle Road.

(Turn left after crossing the Quincentennial Bridge and then take the next left into the University) Some of these spaces are near the University Church, others are beside and in front of the Kingfisher Sports Hall. Most of the spaces are at the back of the University buildings so follow the road with the river on your left and the University buildings on your right.

It is a 5 minute walk to the Fleadh Office and the competition venues from these areas.

Parking at Corrib Village

There are parking spaces in and around the Student accommodation in Corrib Village. It is a 10 minute walk from these areas to the Fleadh Office

Parking further out than Corrib Village

There are a lot parking spaces in the area used for PARK AND RIDE. There is **no** bus ride service from there at the weekend.

It is a 15 –20 minute walk from there to the Fleadh Office and Competition area.

Parking off Campus at the Cathedral

The Cathedral Parking area is a 10 minute walk to the Fleadh Office and Competition area.

A full day rate of Euro 4 applies on Saturday. Free on Sunday. This is a good area to park on Sunday for the Céilí and Set dancing in the Town Hall Theatre which is only 5 minutes walk

Parking off Campus at the Black Box Theatre

The Black Parking area, Dyke Road, is a 20 minute walk to the Fleadh Office and Competition area. In the University
